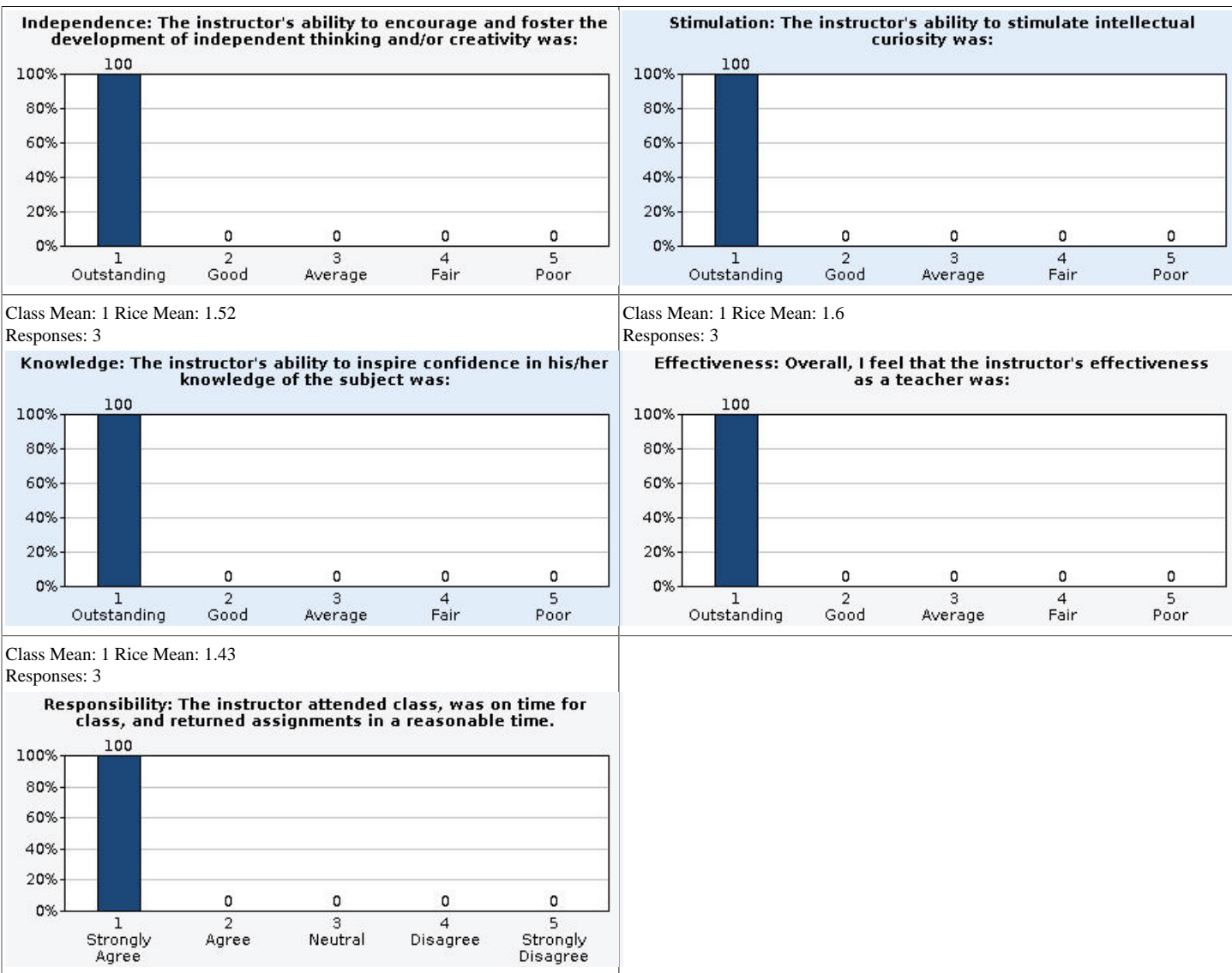

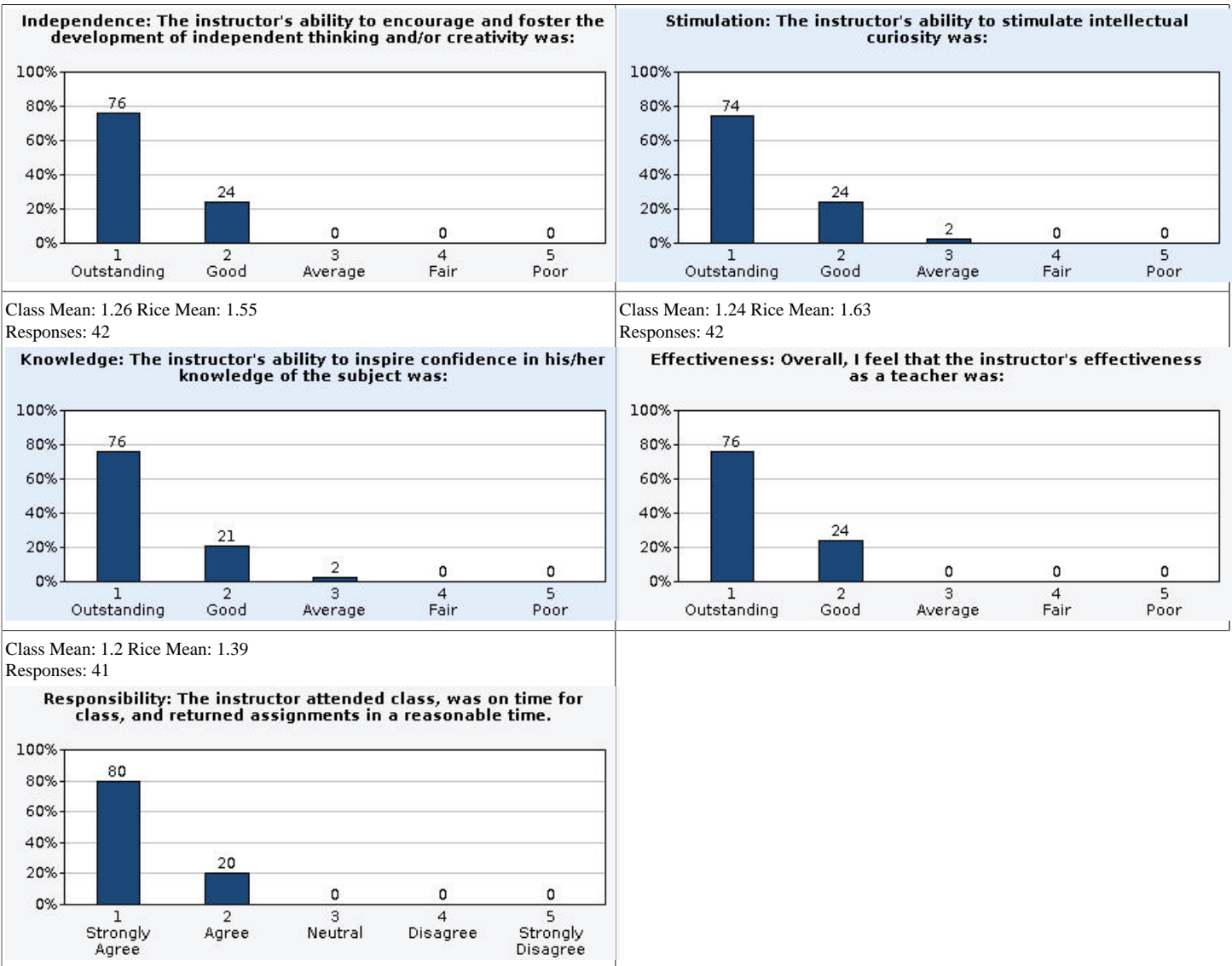

I don't love the biweekly quizzes. The other class I took with Frei also had these. There are definitely pros and cons to them, and I understand for sure where the motivation for them is coming from. However, I feel like they enforce the idea that students should all learn at the same pace (a.k.a. that they have masterful understanding of a topic every two weeks). As a college student, I think this is unrealistic. Sometimes there will be times when you are getting caught up on a concept from 3 or 4 weeks ago because you were preoccupied with life issues or another class for a bit. I think this is a reasonable aspect of studenthood and should not be punished with a bad grade, even if the quizzes don't make up a huge portion of the grade.

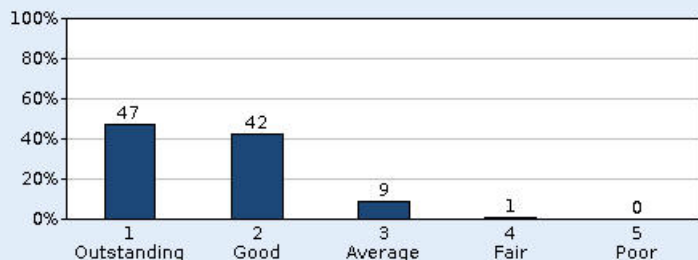

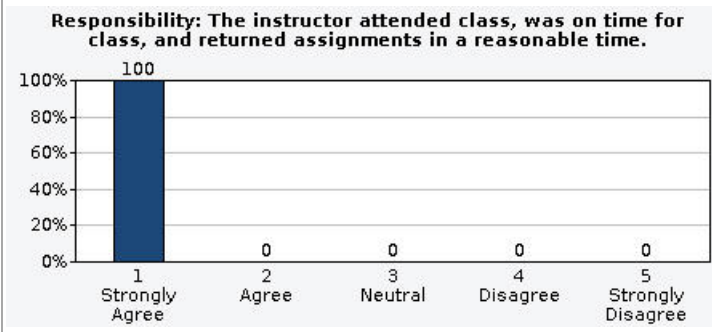
